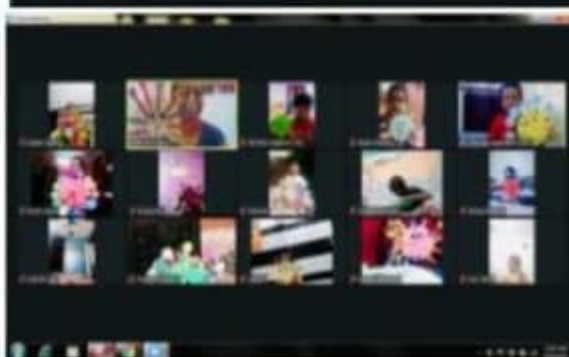


# ELEARNING

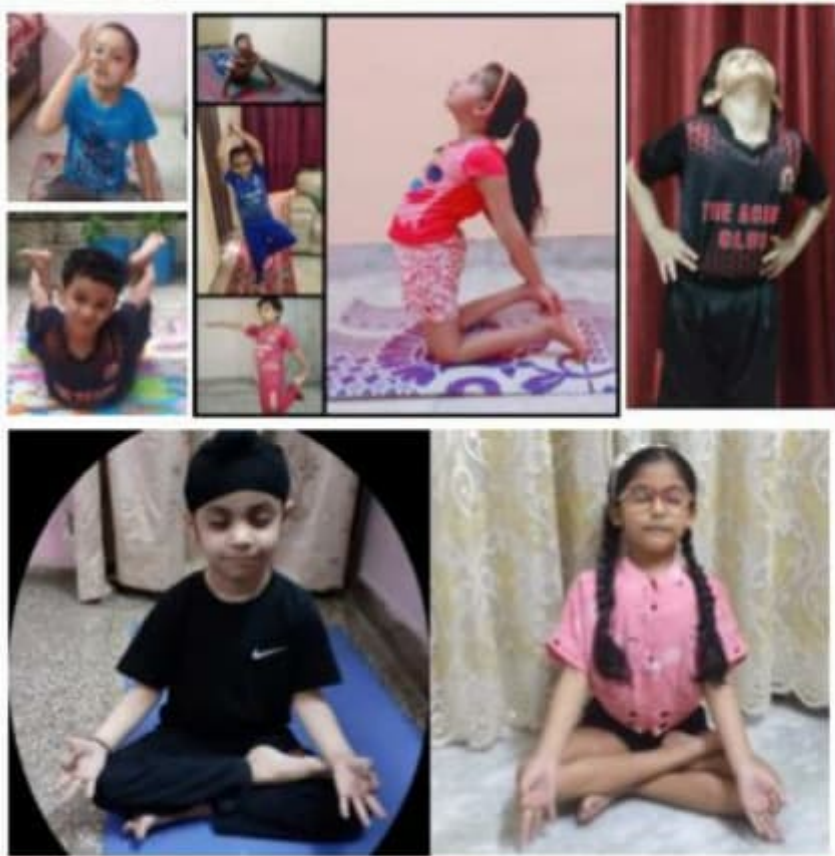






# FITNESS MANTRA

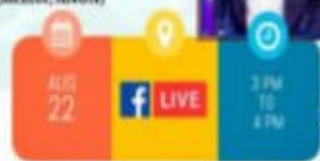
