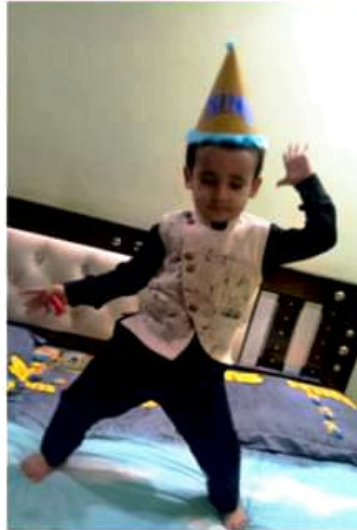
## ZONE FOR CREATIVITY SHOW YOUR MADNESS

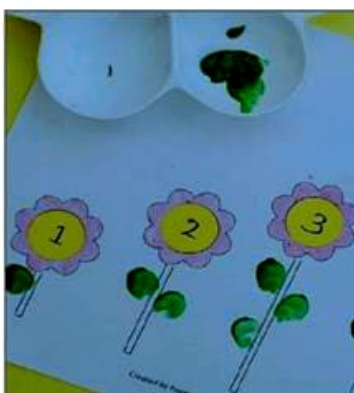
# CONCEPT LEARNING

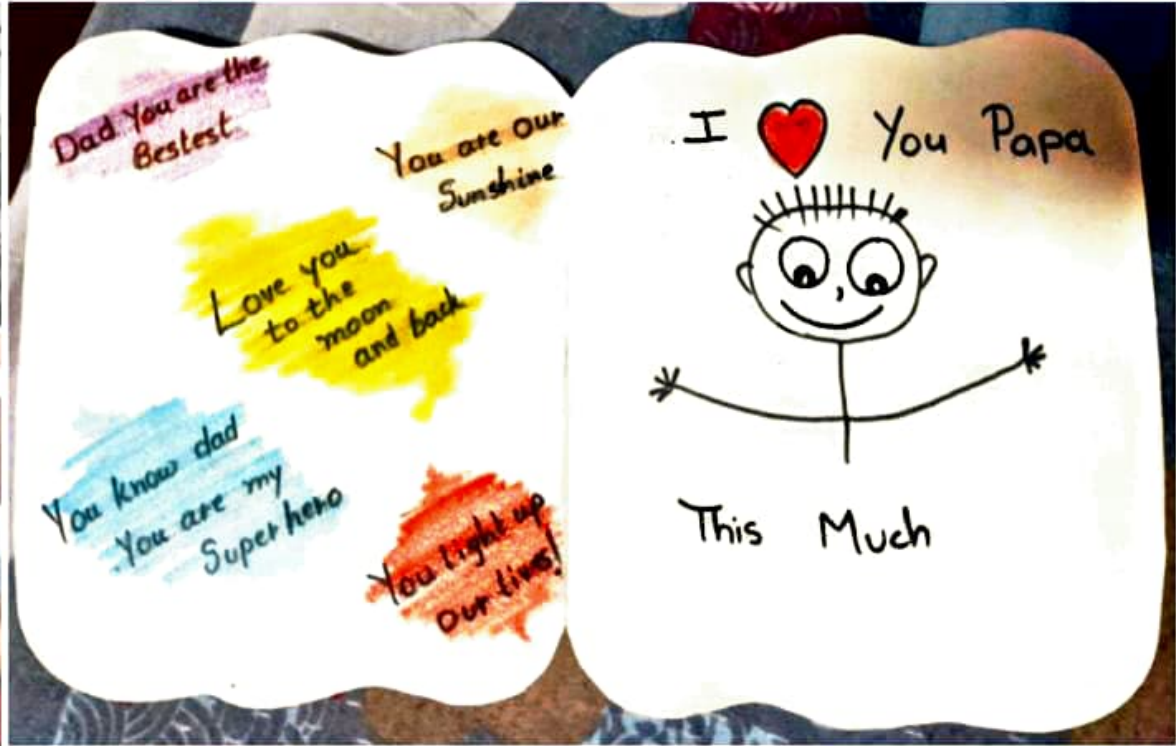

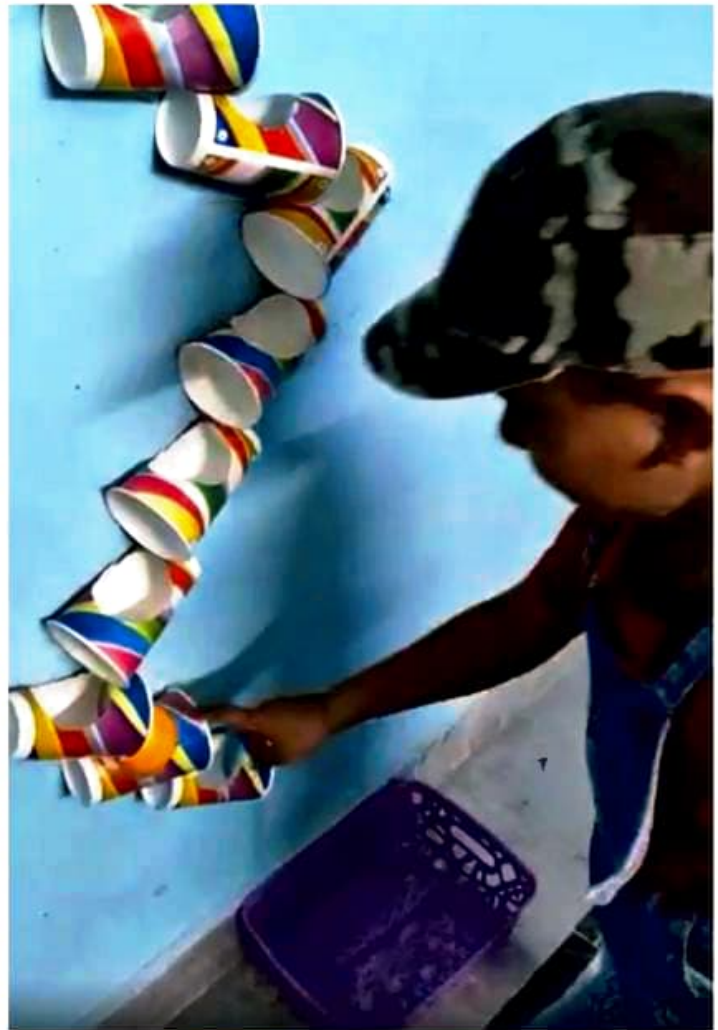

It was a wonderful time to enhance and explore the scientific aptitude of our students by participating in different hand-on activities.

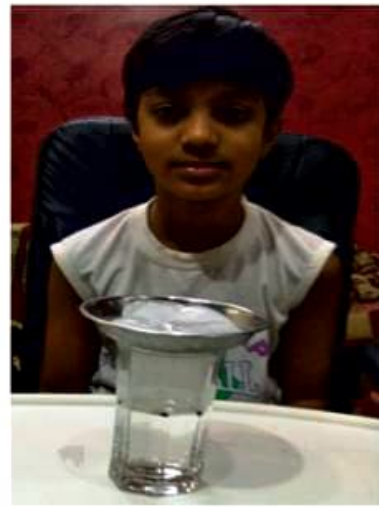
They performed various experiments like formation of clouds, carbondioxide comparison in breathing to the atmosphere.

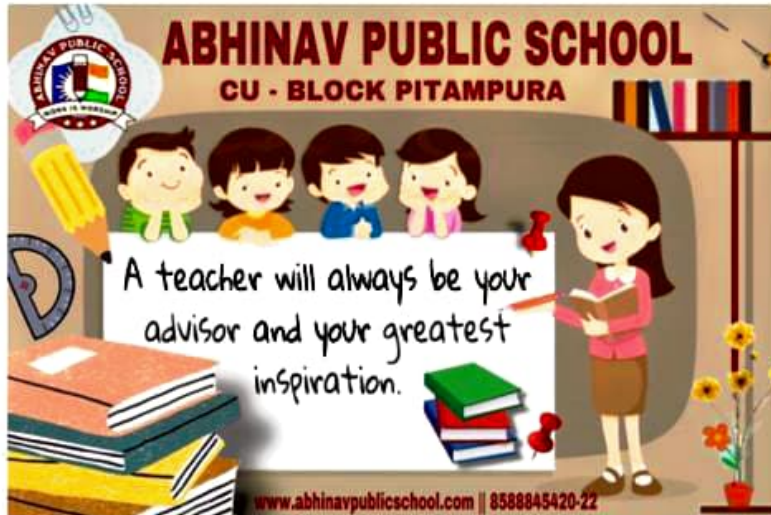

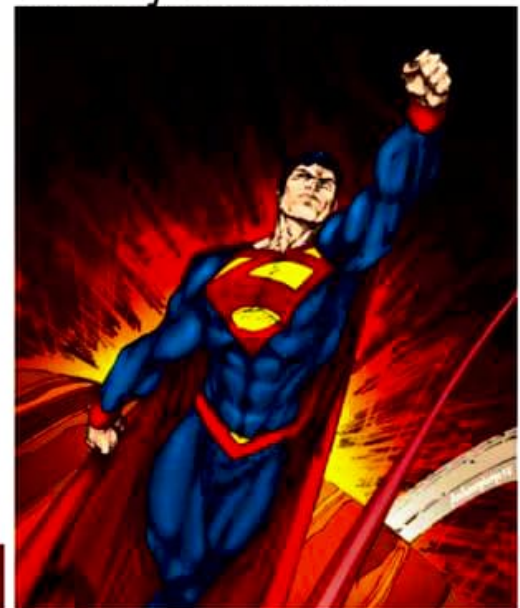
